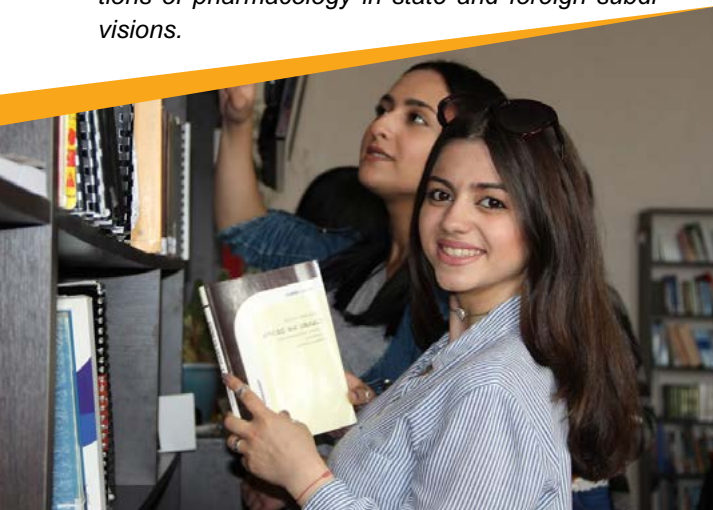

PH. D RESEARCHER

Center for International Relations and Research of Eurasia International University establishes cooperation between international organizations and universities. For overcoming cultural and educational barriers in studying abroad the EIU Center for International Relations and Research developed a mentorship program which enables foreign students to adapt to a new environment. The mentors are generally the student-volunteers who have taken part in Erasmus+ Mobility Exchange Programs and have experienced some cultural challenges therefore. All foreign students are accompanied by mentors and are free to apply them to solve problems arisen.

Mentors can;

- Meet foreign students at “Zvartnots” International Airport (in case of preliminary arrangement)
- Transfer students to the university hostel (if a preliminary application has been submitted)
- Help them in collecting required documents for residence permit
- Consult and support further problems



The admission procedure of foreign students is organized in accordance with N700N (28.04.2011) decree of the Government of the Republic on “Admission to higher educational institutions of the republic of Armenia for foreign”.

Herein:

- If an applicant wants to pass EIU admission (including preparatory courses), the University calls upon Ministry of Education and Science as well as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Armenia for foreign students’ entry permit. Obtaining permission, the applicant may apply to the Embassy of Armenia in the country of his/her residence for entry visa.

- The applicants of having knowledge on prerequisite subjects and a command of English proficiency can enter the University first course.



EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

The EIU Center for International Relations and Research is responsible for offering an exceptional study abroad programs to EIU students.

EIU continuously offers study abroad and exchange programs at leading European universities not only within the framework of EU funded Erasmus+ Exchange Program but also within that of bilateral partnership agreements with many international universities.

Resultantly, the University provides exchange and study abroad opportunities available in the following universities:

The Exchange is organized within the scope of Erasmus+ Program, funded by the European Union. Students receive 700-800 for living expenses. The travel costs are also covered by EU.

The tuition fee for foreign students

- Preparatory courses: \$1800
- Bachelor's degree: \$2400
- Master's degree \$2600
- Doctoral s: \$2800



HOSTEL

Eurasia International University has a separate hostel accommodation for both native and foreign students. The hostel is free for University guests, international faculty members and volunteers. The University Hostel can also be used for the outbound tourism purposes. The number of the rooms are 18 (+7) in N1 Hostel and 21(+8) in N2 Hostel. In all rooms there is a Free WiFi connection.

The Hostel also provides additional paid services, if needed:

- Serving breakfast (1000 AMD per day for one person)
- Meeting at the airport and transfer to the hostel
- Arranging tours around the country
- Renting the computer lab
- Renting the conference hall
- Renting the training auditorium
- Renting the conference room

The Hostel also offers discounts for groups of eight and more visiting for at least ten days.





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
